



# ADMINISTRATION ACTIVITIES

## **Affiliation and Inspection**

- We have submitted the online application for continuation of affiliation for the academic year 2022-23.
- PWD registration for the next five years was received on 27.06.2022.
- Our proposal to upgrade BASLP to embedded degree was accepted by the university from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.
- We received a letter from UGC that clarified the master's degree nomenclature. Therefore, Karnatak University Dharwad accepted our request to start M.Sc. (SLP) and M.Sc. (Aud), and we are now permitted to apply for the next affiliation.
- We successfully submitted the data for All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2021-2022 and we received a certificate as a result (C-53326-2021).

## **Important administration activities**

- Bhoomi Pooja of institute building and hostels was held on 5.04.2022, in the divine presence His Holiness Swamiji, directors and heads of various divisions of MVP and other dignitaries.
- 5th GC meeting was conducted on 08.08.2022, and the proceedings of the meeting were circulated among the members.
- Graduation day ceremony for the batches of 2016–17, 2017–18, and 2018–19 was conducted on 11.08.2022.
- External audit was completed for the academic year 2021-2022 (April 2021-March, 2022).
- Internal audit has been completed from October 2018 to October 2022 and a report has been forwarded to DME.
- The budget for the financial year 2023–2024 has been submitted.
- Students have completed the faculty rating for the odd and even semesters.

- Occupational Therapy services have been started in the institute campus from 12.11.2022 by Dr. Jim Elliot on a weekly basis, after the approval from MVP.





- We have started our services in Karnataka Cancer Hospital, Navanagar, Hubli-Dharwad, on a weekly basis.
- KIMS, Hubli performed their first cochlear implant operation, and switch on was done at our institution on 7.12.2022.
- We have entered MOU with 'Nijalingappa Medical College, Bagalkote and Unity Hospital, Dharwad' for cochlear implant rehabilitation under SAST scheme. Till now, CI switch is been done for 3 cases under SAST scheme at our institute campus.
- We have entered an MOU with 'Nautilus Hearing' pvt Ltd as a part of developing a cost-effective tab-based diagnostic audiometer. Clinical trial and research publication of the product is completed.
- Dr. Jijo. P. M and Mr. Sabarish. A. attended cochlear implant surgeries at KIMS, Hubli on 25.02.2023, where 3 children were implanted under SAST scheme. The children will be sent to our institute for switch on and further rehabilitation.
- Dr. Jijo. P. M and Ms. Theaja Kuriakose have been nominated for RCI inspection as visiting experts.
- A proposal has been forwarded to DME for initiating free services in association with SVYM.



- The Directors' meeting presided by H H Swamiji was held on 02.03.2023 and it was decided to shift speech and language therapy clinic from Srinagar to Kelageri campus.
- Dr. Jijo, P.M. attended Inter-Disciplinary Research Unit (IDRU) meeting on 14.03.2023.

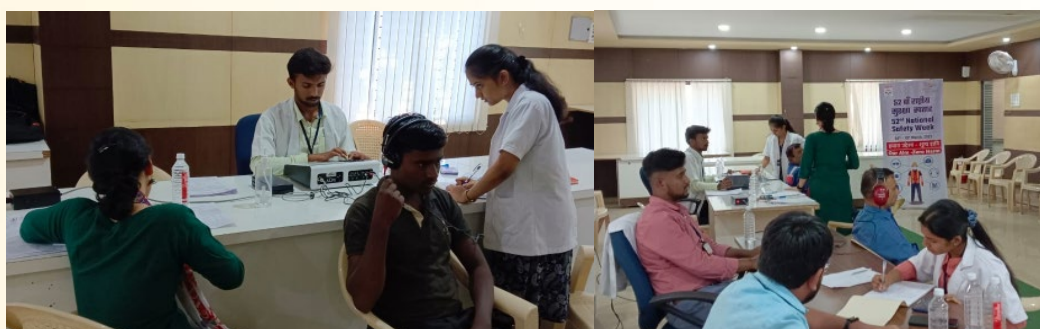


## Camps:

- JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing, Dharwad in association with Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities (Divyangjan), Mumbai. (An autonomous body under the Dept. of Empowerment of persons with disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India) organized a free speech and hearing screening and free hearing aid distribution camp at Dharwad, Karnataka from 22.08.2022 to 24.08.2022, and at Gadag, Karnataka from 25.08.2022 to 26.08.2022. A detailed report has been forwarded to MVP.

- Internship and two 3<sup>rd</sup> BASLP students along with staffs attended Cerebral Palsy camp at Vittal Clinic every month on the first Sunday and evaluated 34 cases in the last year.
- The hearing screening at KUD school was done for 57 children.
- New-born hearing screening was done at Sarvamangala Speciality hospital for 33 infants.
- 148 children were screened for Speech Language and Hearing disorders at Sapthapur Government School and KUD school.
- One-day hearing screening camp was conducted at Time Technoplast LTD, Belur, Dharwad and 102 individuals were screened. Mr. Bharath. R and Mr. Harshavardhan. R. U., along with 2 internship students attended the camp.
- One-day hearing screening camp was conducted at HP Gas Plant, Belur, Dharwad on 07.03.2023 and 114 individuals were screened. Mr. Bharath. R and Ms. Bhagyashree Hegde., along with 4 students from 2<sup>nd</sup> BASLP.



- In association with Swamy Vivekananda Youth Movement (SVYM), Dharwad, Speech and Language screening for stroke patients was conducted at Majethia Foundation, Hubballi (11 members), and at rural area, Dharwad (6 members) on 16.03.2023 and 28.03.2023, respectively.

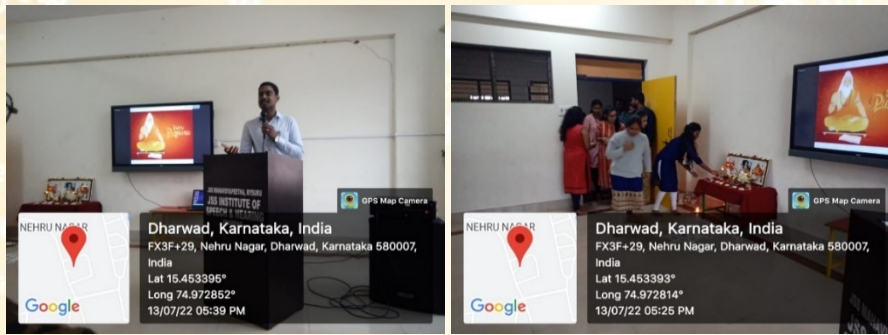
