JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing, Dharwad was established in 2014, with the objectives of providing quality education, affordable clinical services, public education and need based research. The institute is affiliated to Karnatak University, Dharwad, and is recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India, Govt, of India. The institute is the only centre in north Karnataka offers Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (BASLP) course. Clients from all over north Karnataka, Goa and southern Maharashtra avail speech and hearing services from the institute.

Free voice camp was arranged on 16th April to mark the occasion of world voice day and centenary celebration year of Jagadguru Dr. Sri Shivarathri Rajendra Mahaswamiji. Ms. Sandhya, Lecturer, presented an 8 minute talk about the importance of human voice in All India Radio program on 15th April at 06:30 pm. Announcement regarding the camp were made on the AIR Dharwad on 14th, 15th and 16th of April 2016. The advertisement was also published in Vijay Vaani daily newspaper on 16th April 2016. Ten participants attended the camp and their detailed voice evaluation was carried out for free of cost.

REPORT ON AWARENESS PROGRAM FOR STAFF AND STUDENTS OF JSS PUBLIC SCHOOL, DHARWAD ABOUT THE HEARING CONSERVATION AND PROTECTION ON 24th AUGUST 2016

Ms. Sandhya & Mr. Sabarish. A Lecturers conducted awareness program regarding Hearing conservation and protection on 24thAugust 2016 at JSS Public School Dharwad for the students and staff. A total no. of 300 children along with 18 teachers participated in the program. They were educated regarding the normal hearing mechanism in humans, its development and possible damage that can occur if not taken care of. Videos, models, audio samples and Power Point presentations were used to conduct the program. Hearing loss simulator was demonstrated to the participants to explain the difficulties faced by ahearing impaired person. Differences between congenital and acquired deafness were also explained. The program had interactive sessions which were very interesting and fruitful.
