## Clinical activities:



The institute offers audiological diagnosis rehabilitation advanced and using audiological equipments. Hearing assessment, hearing aid trial and hearing aid fitting are carried out for patients of all the age. The institute also offers assessment and management of various speech and language Clients from all over north disorders. Karnataka as well as neighboring states are availing services from the institute.

### **School Screening**

The institute runs school screening programs in various schools in Dharwad. The program aims to identify children with various communication disorders at an early age. Students get the exposure to conduct speech, language and hearing screening programs.

### **Infant Screening**

The institute runs infant hearing screening programs in various hospitals in Dharwad. The program helps in early identification of hearing loss in new born babies and thereby early intervention. Students get exposure to conduct hearing screening using high risk registers, pure-tone screeners and otoacoustic emissions

### **Special Clinics**

JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing, Dharwad in association with Vitthal Institute of Child Health and Specialty Centre, Dharwad conducts monthly special clinic for with cerebral children palsy. This multidisciplinary clinic involves physical medicine rehabilitator, physiotherapist and orthodontist provide to assessment. rehabilitation and home training for children with cerebral palsy.
