JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing, Dharwad, is the second speech and hearing institute of JSS Mahavidyapeetha and was established in 2014. It is affiliated with Karnatak University, Dharwad, and recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), New Delhi.

The Institute offers an Undergraduate Programme in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology, and aims to generate proficient human resources in the field. It also reaches out to people with communication disorders in North Karnataka.

In our society, people with disabilities are facing difficulties and are sidelined. JSS Mahavidyapeetha believes that proper care, guidance, education and the help of experts can bring such people to the mainstream. JSS Institute of Speech and Hearing, Dharwad, has been established to fulfil this goal.



Scope for Speech Language Pathologists and Audiologists

Speech Language Pathologists and Audiologists help individuals of all age groups having the following problems.

- Inability to hear sounds or speech
- Inability to speak (since childhood or acquired later)
- Voice problems (for example; male speaking like female or having harsh or hoarse voice).
- Speaking through nose, nasalized speech/cleft lip/cleft palate
- Stuttering or stammering
- Reading difficulty (Dyslexia) and/or Learning disability.
- Swallowing difficulty (Dysphagia)
- Mental retardation
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Cerebral palsy






Curriculum

Four-year Undergraduate Programme is divided into 8 semesters (including 1-year internship). The students will study the following subjects during the first 3 years of BASLP.

- Core subjects
 - 1) Speech, Language and Hearing Sciences
 - 2) Speech, Language Pathology
 - 3) Audiology

- Medical subjects
 - 1) Anatomy and Physiology of Speech and Hearing Mechanism
 - 2) Otolaryngology
 - 3) Genetics
 - 4) Pediatrics
 - 5) Neurology

- Allied subjects
 - 1) Clinical Psychology
 - 2) Linguistics and Phonetics
 - 3) Electronics and Acoustics
 - 4) Research Methods and Statistics
 - 5) Organization and Administration







Eligibility for admission for BASLP program

- 1. Candidates who have obtained a minimum of 50% (45% in the case of SC/ST candidates) in the pre-university or 10+2 examination are eligible for admission.
- Candidates should have studied Physics,
 Chemistry and Biology/
 Mathematics/Computer
 Science/Statistics/Electronics/Psychology in
 their PUC or qualifying examination.
- 3. There are 40 seats available for the BASLP course. Interested candidates can download the application on our official website www.jssishdharwad.org and apply online.

1. Library and information Centre

The library has more than 2000 books on Audiology, Speech and Hearing Sciences, Speech-Language Pathology and allied subjects. The students have access to more than 1500 E-books and 100 Scientific Journals related to speech and hearing. There is also a reading room with an internet facility.

2. Well equipped labs

The Institution and clinic are well equipped with state-of-the-art facilities required for diagnosing and treating speech, language and hearing problems in individuals across ages.

















3. Speech Science & Hearing Science Laboratories

The Speech Science and Hearing Science Laboratories are established to train the students in basic and advanced hearing, speech and language knowledge. The computers are loaded with software to help them learn to analyze normal and pathological aspects of speech production, articulation, hearing, linguistics, phonetics, etc.

3. Placement Cell

Guidance regarding suitable placements and good career opportunities at domestic and global levels are provided for the interns. Campus interviews are also conducted by various hearing aids and cochlear implant companies, along with renowned global placement agencies for speech-language pathologists and audiologists.

4. Hostel and Bus Facilities

Separate Hostels are available for boys and girls along with transportation facilities.
