Women's day was celebrated on 08.03.2022 by staffs and students of the institute. Various activities like dance, song, mime, games etc, were organised.




• Cultural week was celebrated on 10.03.2022 by organizing various competitions, including singing, dancing, and mad arts.

- On the occasion of 'World Environment Day', created an awareness video on afforestation, and also trees were planted within institute campus on 05.06.2021.


