
What is Cleft lip and palate?

Cleft lip and palate are openings or splits in the upper lip, the roof of the mouth or both.

Types of cleft lip and palate:

- 1. Cleft of lip (Opening on one side/ both the sides)
- 2. Cleft of palate (Complete, Incomplete)
- 3. Cleft of lip and palate



How does it occur?

• If the tissues fail to form completely, it results in a gap during fetal development.

Possible causes:

- Heredity
- Maternal infections and toxic effects of rubella during first trimester.

Symptoms

- Immediately identifiable at birth by visual inspection
- A split in the lip and roof of the mouth that can affect one / both sides of the face

Problems associated with cleft lip and palate:

- Difficulty with feeding: Food coming out of nose, Hygienic issues, increased feeding duration may increase physical and mental stress to baby and mother etc
- Difficulty in swallowing
- Chronic ear infections and hearing loss.
- Social and emotional problems

Speech problems:

- ✤ Nasal speaking voice
- Dental problems
- Pronunciation errors may be found

Treatment

1. **Surgical treatment**: Surgery involves stitching of lip and palate skin together.

2. **Prosthetic management**: This aids the patient in developing normal speech, promoting swallowing and in closing off the oral cavity from the nasal cavity.



3. **Speech Therapy**: The Speech Language Pathologist can provide, from an early age, information about feeding, oral motor function and speech. Speech therapy helps in correcting the nasal speech and pronunciation errors.



Myths or misbeliefs

- Cleft occurs because of sin done by the mother in past life.
- Cleft lip and plate is purely a cosmetic concern
- A cleft lip is the same thing as a cleft palate
- Cleft cannot be treated with surgery
- One surgery is enough to repair a cleft lip
- Speech of a child with cleft cannot be corrected.
